LIAISON OFFICER RECRUITMENT DRIVE & TRAINING

Greetings to our fellow members of the Public Service Union of Belize!

The Public Service Union of Belize (PSU) is embarking on a National Liaison Officer Recruitment Drive. This is being done in an effort to address grievances in a timely and efficient matter, strengthen our membership, enhance our employee/employer relations, and provide improved representation in office. With recruitment comes training. Liaison Officer Training will be conducted every Thursday 9AM to 4PM at one of the Branches starting July 22, 2021.

The PSU Constitution Section 32(10) states, The branches shall be so organized that at the workplace or in each department or section, Liaison Officers are to be appointed or elected by the branch committee. The Liaison Officer's primary role shall be to represent the union at the workplace and he/she shall be responsible for reporting member grievances to the branch committee or the branch chairperson. Liaison Officers shall hold office at the pleasure of the union.

- 6. September 2 Belize Branch (Belize City)
- 7. September 9 -Belmopan Branch (Belmopan City)
