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PRESS RELEASE

The Public Service Union of Belize (PSU) held its 104th Annual General Meeting on 13th and 14th August at the Santa Elena Sports Complex, Cayo District under the theme "One Vision. One Voice. One Union. PSU 104 years Strong!"

The two-day Annual General Meeting (AGM) commenced on Thursday evening with an Invocation by Pastor Michael Ogaldez, followed by the Welcome Address by Mayor Earl Trapp, Santa Elena and San Ignacio Towns.

The Guest Speaker, Bro. Ray Davis, although he was unable to be present, submitted a thought-provoking challenge to members to reflect deeply on the meaning of the AGM theme, **"One Vision, One Voice, One Union. PSU 104 Years Strong!"**, particularly the significance of "One Voice" in an increasingly noisy and complex information environment. He questioned what the collective voice of the Union should represent and emphasized that it must be informed by the lived experiences of PSU members, proper research, and the Union's historical antecedents. He noted that this voice must be capable of inspiring, challenging, repudiating, and consoling, while ultimately being echoed by members throughout a public service committed to providing timely, efficient, and high-quality services to the Belizean population. Bro. Davis further connected "One Union" to the core constitutional objectives of the PSU, including the organization of public officers, the promotion and protection of members' interests and welfare, and the promotion of goodwill and harmony.

During the Business Session on Friday, the posts of 1st Vice President, National Treasurer, Assistant Secretary General, (2) Councillors, and (2) Trustees were up for election.
